Care in Use

MiA[™] films are durable however softer than wood veneers, kitchen worksurfaces, Formica, ceramic and metals, so the user should handle appropriately with care in use.

Cleaning and Maintenance

Clean with a microfibre cloth and soap and warm water. Do not use abrasive cleaners. Do not use caustic cleaners, solvent or petroleum-based cleaners. Physical damage can be repaired in some cases with the use of gentle heat.

Removal

At the end of use, the film can be removed cleanly from most surfaces. Gentle heat will aid removal. If there is residual adhesive, remove with Metamark IPA, Surface Cleaner or Adhesive Remover. Adhesive films generally do not remove cleanly from emulsion surfaces as the bond of the film to the paint is stronger than the paint to the plaster, so plastered walls will require re painting.

Disposal

Dispose of the release backing paper, and the film, in general waste, where no recycling stream is available. The face film is suitable for recycling in Metamark MetaStream[®] closed loop recycling, if available in your region. Call to find out more.
